

## Healthy start as work begins on new £9m centre

WORK has begun on a new £9m health centre for west Leeds.

The area's MP John Battle - pictured with Dr Amanda Robinson from Butt Lane Surgery, Farnley - unveiled a plaque at Lower Wortley Enhanced Primary Care Centre, which is being built near the Ringways roundabout on the A6110 outer ring road.

The centre will house two GP surgeries which will move there when it opens next year, as well as a minor surgery theatre, dieticians, an addiction clinic, community pharmacy and smoking cessation service. Health visitors, district nurses, and other health workers will be based there too.

John Battle said: "I am absolutely delighted to be able to mark the beginning of work on what will be a first class, convenient health centre."
